Item No. 16.01:

Confirmation of the Minutes of the 15th Meeting of the Board of Governors (BoG) of CIT held on 24th January, 2018 in the Conference Hall, CIT Guest House, Kokrajhar.

Action taken Report (ATR) on the Resolutions of the 15th Meeting of the BoG.

An ATR on the resolution was prepared and placed before the members for discussion and suggestions of further course of action if any, that may be considered.

Resolution: The members minutely noted the ATR.

Item No.16.03:

Reporting on some significant activities of the institute.

- 1. For proper functioning of the Central library of the institute, an institutional **Library Committee** is constituted. The Committee consists of a Chairman, Member Secretary and representatives (as members of the committee) from all the departments. The name of the chairman is being nominated by the Director of the institute. The member Secretary will be the Librarian of the Central library of the institute and the departmental representatives will be nominated by the HoDs of the respective departments. The tenure of the newly appointed members will be for one year.
- 2. An Innovation Cell is established at CIT Kokrajhar with the following objectives:
 - To capture the inventions and innovations at the student level (Degree and Diploma students both)
 - To provide mentorship for students' projects (by faculty members) with financial and technical support from the institute.
 - To create the start-up cell using active membership from faculty members.
 - To provide initial one time financial and expert support for company registration.
 - To liason with National Innovation Foundation (NIF) that protects Intellectual Property right (IPR) for all citizen from grassroots level to

upper root level technocrats in India by taking them into their fold through various forums.

Requirement Analysis: The establishment of innovation cell is proposed on the basis of requirement analysis from point of view of placement of students in their remote regions where arrangement placement has its own bottleneck. The students are required to fend for their own placement activities going outside the region. Moreover, the student will be equipped with an Intellectual Property (IP) portfolio of their own which could help them in future. The requirement of the institute to get a rank in various competitive rankers' analysis is essential. The innovation cell is expected to move the rank of the institute higher in the ladder.

Membership: All the employees (staff and faculty members) and students by default are members of the innovation cell. A body of office bearers will be created under the supervisions of the Director and Registrar.

Resolution: The members noted the reporting.
