

**Minutes of  
3<sup>rd</sup> Academic Committee Meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2017 in the Conference Hall,  
CIT Guest House, Kokrajhar at 11-00 A.M.**

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**Item No. 03.01:** Confirmation of the Minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Academic Committee held on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2015 at Conference Hall, CIT Guest House, Kokrajhar.

The minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Academic Committee was circulated to the members for seeking comments if any. As no comments were received from the members, the minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting was placed for confirmation.

**Resolution:** After threadbare discussion the members confirmed the minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Academic Committee Meeting confirmed.

**Item No. 03.02:** Action Taken Report (ATR) on the resolutions of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Academic Committee held on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2015.

An ATR had been prepared and placed on the resolutions of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Academic Committee. Members were requested to discuss the ATR and suggest further course of action if any.

**Resolution:** Members discussed the action taken report and recommended Item 2.03 and 2.08 be discussed as a separate agenda. The following decisions were taken

**Item 2.04 - Proposal for Introduction of new branches of ME & EE :** It is resolved that CIT Kokrajhar being a modular pattern Institute, Diploma programme in ME and EE be initiated & then move to B. Tech programme.

**Item No. 03.03:** Proposal for introduction of new P.G Programmes in the Department of Civil Engineering and Department of Food Engineering & Technology.

The Department of Civil Engineering, CIT Kokrajhar has given proposal for opening M.Tech Programmes in the following Specializations

- A. Geotechnical Engineering.
- B. Environmental Engineering

The Department of Food Engineering and Technology had also given proposal for opening M.Tech programme in Food Engineering and Technology.

The members were requested to advice on this

**Resolution:** Approved in principle.

After discussion the Members decided that instead of starting with two new P.G programmes in Civil Engineering, the Department should start a single P.G programme on the basis of faculty strength and specialization. The members advised that the detailed draft proposal including course curriculum of P.G programmes which have been submitted by the departments of Civil Engineering (CE) and department of Food Engineering and Technology (FET) needs to be reviewed by inviting expert comments. The members also suggested that the affiliation process for the P.G programmes be initiated simultaneously by approaching ASTU, Guwahati with the detailed draft proposal and course curriculum of the P.G programmes.



Item No. 03.04:

**Proposal for Approval of the Mission and Vision statements of the Departments.**

The Institute is planning for NBA Accreditation of all the departments. In this regard, the Departments have prepared the Mission and Vision statements, which was placed for discussion.

The members were requested to peruse the same and consider for approval.

**Resolution:** The members went through the draft statement of Vision and Mission statements submitted by the Departments of CIT Kokrajhar. The members recommends for a consistent set of Vision and Mission and suggested that a committee be formed to examine the draft Vision and Mission statements.

Item No. 03.05

**Proposal for approval of B.Des syllabus, B.Des Admission Procedure and B.Des Programme Regulation.**

**(i) Proposal for approval of B.Des Syllabus.**

With the approval of 2<sup>nd</sup> Academic committee meeting, Bachelors of Design (Multimedia Communication and Design) course has started under ASTU (Assam Science and Technology University) from the academic year 2016. The Department seeks the approval of syllabus of B.Des course, i.e. prepared under the guidance of senior Professors of IIT Guwahati.

**(ii) Proposal for approval B.Des. Admission procedure.**

Department has prepared admission procedure for entry into B.Des. programme in association with Admission Committee, CIT Kokrajhar. The 1<sup>st</sup> Batch started with 20 students in July 2016 through the new procedure adapted. This year in 2017, with the approval of Chairman CIT Society the institute is planning to take candidates from UCEED entrance conducted by IIT Bombay along with CITBDAT exam conducted by CIT itself for B.Des.admission. The department seeks the approval of B.Des Admission procedure.

**(iii) Proposal for approval B.Des. Programme Regulation.**

The Department of Multimedia Communication and Design has prepared regulation for 4 year B.Des. Programme under the guidance of senior Professors of IIT Guwahati. The department seeks the approval of B.Des. Programme Regulation

**(iv) Proposal for NBA and AICTE approval of Dept. of Multimedia Communication and Design.**

AICTE approval of new course/ programme requires NBA approval of minimum courses (existing) run by the institute. Since the department has already started the B.Des programme, the department seeks proposal for NBA and AICTE approval of Dept. of Multimedia Communication and Design.

**Resolution:** -Members discussed the proposals and suggested for forwarding the same to the affiliating University ASTU, Guwahati for further course of action.

**It is also advised that the** Design dept. may also float common design courses as an open elective to the other departments.

NBA accreditation for the departments be initiated. Dept. of MCD may go for the NBA accreditation for Diploma programme.

Item No. 03.06:

**Reporting on the Academic Activities of the Institute.**

The Institute runs 3 years Diploma Courses in six branches of Engineering and 4 years B.Tech courses in six branches of Engineering. The branches in Diploma are Electronics & Telecommunications Engineering, Computer Science and Engineering, Control & Instrumentation Engineering, Food Process Technology, Construction Technology and Animation & Multimedia Technology. B.Tech courses are in the branches of Electronics & Communications Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Instrumentation Engineering, Food Engineering & Technology, Civil Engineering and Information Technology.

**Affiliation:** The Institute works in a bi-semester system with 75 working days in a semester. The Diploma courses are affiliated to State Council of Technical Education, Assam, while the B.Tech courses are affiliated to Gauhati University, Assam.

**Evaluation:** The Diploma courses are evaluated on a ratio of 30:70 to Sessionals and End-Semester examinations with the sessionals broken up into Class Tests/Assignments (10), Mid-Term examinations (10) and Attendance (10) components. The Degree courses are on a ratio of 40:60 to Sessionals and End-semester examinations with the sessionals divided into Class Tests/Assignments (15), Mid-Term examinations (25) and Attendance (5).

**Faculty Strength:** The present faculty strength of the institute stands at 76 regular, 3 contractual and 2 Visiting Lecturers.

**Distinguished Professor:** Prof. Krishnamachar Sreenivasan joined the institute as a distinguished Professor in the Department of Information Technology for a period of two years.

**Academic Programmes Organised:**

1. Entrepreneurship Development Cell, CIT Kokrajhar organized a short term program on "Entrepreneurial Skill Development" during 2 to 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2017.
2. Department of HSS, CIT Kokrajhar organized an International Seminar On "Language Documentation its Significance and Scopes in North East India" on 16<sup>th</sup> December ,2016
3. Department of F.E.T, CIT Kokrajhar Organized a 2 days' Workshop on "Food Safety and Management System (FSMS)" on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2016 on the Topic "Internal Auditor Training on ISO 22000: 2005" in collaboration with SGS India Pvt. Ltd., New Town, Kolkata.
4. Department of IT, CSE and HSS jointly hosted an International Workshop on " Role of Technological Advances, Incubation Themes and Engineering Skills" (TAITES 2016) during January 21-23, 2016.

**Reporting on the Activities undertaken by the Admission Committee.**

The Admission Committee takes responsibility for conducting the Entrance Examinations and Admission to Diploma, B. Tech (Direct Entry) ,B. Tech (Lateral Entry/Vertical Entry) and B.Des. programmes.

**Diploma Admission:** The total number of seats in Diploma programme is 180 with 30 in each of the six branches. Out of the total number of seats, 80% of the seats are offered through the Entrance CITEE conducted by CIT, Kokrajhar while 20% of the seats drawn from those seats reserved for BTAD and North East Assam are offered through Polytechnic Admission Test (PAT) conducted by Directorate of Technical Education, Assam.

**B.Tech (Direct Entry) Admissions:** The total number of seats for B.Tech (Direct Entry) is 270 with 45 in each of the six branches. Out of the total seats under Direct Entry Scheme, 40% of the seats are offered for those candidates having qualifying marks in JEE Mains and 60% of the seats for those qualifying in the Entrance CITDEE conducted by CIT, Kokrajhar.

**Vertical/Lateral Entry Admissions:** Under the Lateral Entry Scheme, 15 seats in each branch are reserved for eligible candidates of CIT through Vertical mobility while 6 seats are open for qualified candidates of other AICTE recognized institutes through the entrance CITLET conducted by CIT, Kokrajhar.

**B.Des Admissions:** The total number of seats for B.Des is 45 through Direct Entry and 15 through Vertical Entry. The admission for B.Des programme will be through UCEED and CITBDAT entrance examination.

**Reservation Policy:** The institute follows the following reservation policy.

(v) 60% from BTC (60% ST, 5% SC, 15% OBC and 20% General)

(vi) 20% from North-East region excluding BTC.

(vii) 17% from All India excluding North-East Region.

(viii) 03% for physically handicapped candidates irrespective of region.

The selection of serial no.(ii), (iii) & (iv) follow the reservation policy for SC, ST, OBC and General as laid down by the Central Government. In the second round of counselling and admission, the vacant seats of BTAD region are offered to candidates of NE region. In the third round, the vacant seats are offered to all India candidates keeping the reservation for SC/ST intact.

However, the steps regarding its implementation (approval from Gauhati University) could not be initiated as the institute is preparing for its deemed university status. As of now, the deemed university status is under process which may take time. Since syllabus upgradation is an urgent issue, this matter is forwarded for discussion in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Academic Committee Meeting.

**Resolution:** Proposal for revision the B. Tech course structure was approved and the members suggested that the Institute should forward the proposal to GU, Guwahati for their consent.

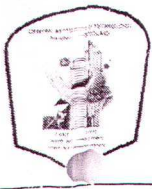
**2. (Item 02.08) : Proposal for change in Grading System (10 point) from Absolute to Relative**

**Resolution:** The members suggested that the proposed grading system change may be forwarded to affiliating University.










